Parkland, Florida on a map, there were my friends - at least my Facebook kind. They seemed more interested in bashing NRA members and Republicans in general, than grieving with families and friends of the dead. But here's what they said about people like me: We care

## more about guns than

 dead kids.Of course neither of those premises are correct. They are straw man arguments at their finest. Put forth a hyperbolic statement about someone as if it were true, and then counter it. It's an interesting technique in debate class, but really useless if we want to solve any problems in this world.
A new trend reaction to tragedies - but only those caused by a killer with a gun, or if Trump can somehow be blamed -is to

say that thoughts and prayers do nothing. If we really care about our fellow man, instead of offering prayer, we will offer solutions.
Haven't many of us been taught that when we can't find a solution, we turn to God? That even when it seems like our prayers aren't doing anything, that our
Savior has a greater plan? But there are people out there who have never been exposed to this philosophy - or have rejected it. A Godless world is becoming increasingly accepted so cutting words about something so precious as personal prayer is sad, but not unexpected.
Listening to a Christian radio station, I heard an artist talking about her new hit song "Broken Prayers". She was explaining why she wrote it and said "God delights in our brokenness." I thought, what an easy comment to attack if you were uneducated or hostile toward Christianity. Why would we praise and glorify a God who likes to see His people broken? Of course He doesn't.
Parents hate to see their children hurting. But in that hurting, they want nothing more than their children to come to them with their problems, to allow them to help or offer comfort. That is how God delights in our problems. Christians instinctively

understand that.
There is no question that young men getting firearms and then mowing people down with them is a problem. Could there be more stringent laws or oversight, especially regarding youth or the mentally ill? Yes. But is there a deeper problem that surpasses the mere possession of a gun? Absolutely yes. Until we discover what it is, we will throw shadows at solutions unlikely to work. As for me, I still believe that asking God to exit the scene won't lead to anything positive.
And now Billy Graham has passed away. I couldn't help but think that he was just a little too good for this world we live in now. A self proclaimed introvert who reached millions of people with a passionate message about Jesus Christ, he refused to hit hot-button issues, but stuck to promoting the Gospel. He said his words during revivals were not his own, but God's.
Coming of age today, would he be called mentally ill by talk show hosts because he claimed to hear and follow God's words? Would he be roundly criticized for supporting every president that inhabited the Oval Office? Would he be ostracized because he refused to claim devout support to one politician or the other? Would someone somewhere hire Gloria Allred and falsely claim sexual harassment? These are tendencies now, rocketed by a secular and
self-absorbed world.
fractured families, advancementof technology over humanity - these are the real issues that we are dealing with. People abandoned in the name of any of them need our prayers AND our solutions. Hopefully we are capable of seeking both.

USDA Launches Weppage Highlighting Resources to Help Rural Communities Addresss the Opioid Crisis

Assistant to the Secretary for Rural Development Anne Hazlett today unveiled a new webpage featuring resources to help rural communities respond to the opioid crisis.
"While no corner of the country has gone untouched by the opioid crisis, small towns and rural places have been particularly hard hit," Hazlett said. "The challenge of opioid misuse is an issue of rural prosperity and will take all hands on deck to address. The webpage we are launching today will help rural leaders build a response that is tailored to meet the needs of their community."
The National Center for Health Statistics estimates that more than 63,000 Americans died from drug overdoses in 2016. More than half of those deaths involved opioids, including prescription drugs and heroin.
USDA is playing an important role to help rural communities address this national problem at the local level through program investment, strategic partnerships and best practice implementation. In April 2017, President Donald J. Trump established the Interagency Task Force on

Agriculture and Rural Prosperity to identify legislative, regulatory and policy changes that could promote agriculture and prosperity in rural communities. In January 2018, Secretary Perdue presented the Task Force's findings to President Trump, which included 31 recommendations to align the federal government with state, local and tribal governments to take a dvantage of opportunities that exist in rural America
In the area of quality of life, the Task Force included recommendation to modernize health care access. The report highlighted the importanceof telemedicine in enhancing access to primary care and specialty providers. The Task Force also found that improved access to mental and behavioral health care, particularly prevention, treatment and recovery resources, is vital to addressing the opioid crisis and other substance misuse in rural communities.

## Calf Pneumonia

Cause
Calf pneumonia is a majo problem in dairy and bee herds. It is a multifactorial disease, and the most common post-mortem diagnosis in calves between one to five months of age. Infectious agents involved include Mannheimia haemolytica, Haemophilus somnus, Infectious Bovine Rhinotracheitis (IBR) bovine Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) and Parainfluenza III Virus (PI3), along with many other bacteria and mycoplasma species and viruses.
Environmental factors include low environmental temperatures and high humidity and poor ventilation and also direct draughts onto calves
themselves. The relationship between season and outbreaks may also be related to management practices including calving pattern and mixing of different ages of calves. There are two types of the disease, acute and chronic. Symptoms
Dull and depressed High temperature
Raised breathing due to lung damage
Nasal discharge
Coughing
Reduced food intake
Chronic pneumonia is more gradual in onset with no distinct ill phase and the cow may appear to still eat well but may have a slight nasal discharge, sometimes with an increased respiratory rate and cough.

Treatment
Antibiotics, antiinflammatories or anthelmintics can be prescribed for treatment. Prevention
It can be difficult to control pneumonia when calves are placed in communal pens. Improved husbandry ventilation and good nursing care can all reduce risks of pneumonia, as well as ensuring that young animals receive appropriate amounts of colostrum within the first 24 hours of birth.
Colostrum: : All calves must have one gallon of colostrum within four to six hours of birth to receive adequate immunity. Calves that are not given enough antibodies at birth are at increased risk for pneumonia and scours throughout the entire growing period. The most important step in any calf health-management programme is a successful

- Money is an end, not a means to an end.
- Hard work is always rewarded.
- I'm not smart/capable enough to earn a lot of money.
- Live for today-the future doesn't matter.
- High debt is normal.
- The man should make all the financial decisions. - You must work long hours and neglect your family in order to earn a good income.
- You're not supposed to talk about money.
- Buying expensive gifts proves that you love someone.

Your current health and financial decisions are influenced by what you've seen and heard since childhood.
Are you ready to break free of negative thought patterns that have been weighing you down emotionally, physically, and financially? Put them in writing and you can start to address them. "Understanding your baggage" is a critical first step on the path to health and wealth.

## Fog Fever

Also known as Acute Bovine Pulmonary Edema and Emphysema (ABPEE).
Fog fever is an acute pneumonia of adult cattle which occurs within four to 10 days of moving from an over grazed pasture or dry feed, to a fresh, lush green pasture. The condition develops rapidly.
It typically occurs in
Autumn, five to 10 days after the change to lush grass. Cause

The affected cattle have been on dry feed for an extended period of time and
the rumen fermentation the rumen fermentation
pattern has adapted to this situation. With the change to lush green pasture the dietary protein concentration increases dramatically. One of the amino acids in this plant protein, tryptophan, is the culprit. The tryptophan in the feed is converted by rumen bacteria to a
substance called 3 methylindole (3-MI) at a very high rate.

This $3-\mathrm{MI}$ is absorbed through the rumen wall and circulated around the body The 3 -MI is toxic to the primary cells that line the interior surface of the lungs. Thus, as the high levels of 3MI move from the rumen to the lungs more and more lung tissue is destroyed. lung tissue

There is no specific treatment for fog fever. Mild cases may recover without treatment.
Most severely affected cattle will not respond to any treatment and will die within a day or two
Removing cows from pasture has not been scientifically proven to reduce cases. Some believe it prevents further cases

whilst others believe that moving sick animals can make the disease worse. Prevention
Limiting time grazing in the first 10 days when cattle are moved to a new pasture will reduce the chances of cattle falling ill.
Allowing cattle to graze a couple of hours a day and building this up is advisable. It is also thought that feeding m 0 n e n s in or
chlortetracycline for the first 10 days can help control the situation.

Prevention is important as it a herd to become ill, and up is common for 50 per cent of to 30 per cent may die.

Sen. Ron Sharp carried the nomination last Thursday of long-time public safety officer Major Rusty Rhoades to serve as the Commissioner of Public Safety. The Senate Public Safety Committee approved the nomination unanimously.
"Major Rhoades has dedicated his life to serving the people of Oklahoma and improving public safety throughout the state," said Sharp, R-Shawnee. "He will be a strong leader for the Department of Public Safety and we look forward to seeing his vision for how to strengthen and continue to improve public safety in our state."
As the Commissioner, Major Rhoades will command the Oklahoma Highway Patrol and also serve concurrently as the Governor's Cabinet Secretary for Safety and Security. As a member of the Cabinet, Major Rhoades will be responsible for directing all state public safety and corrections agencies.
Billy D. "Rusty" Rhoades III is an Oklahoma Highway Patrol Major who has served the Department of Public Safety for 28 years in various areas. Since 2009, he has served as Zone Commander and is responsible for Field Operations in four Troops (Altus, Clinton, Guymon and Enid). He has also served as a Zone Commander for Oklahoma City, the State Capitol Complex and turnpikes.
Since 2006, Major Rhoades has also represented the Commissioner's office as the DPS Legislative Liaison. He represented the Commissioner's and Chief's Offices at the State Capitol and served as a point of contact for state elected officials, legislative staff and the media.
Earlier in his career, he served as the Highway Patrol's Liaison with the FBI Oklahoma City regarding national and international terrorism. His case work included both domestic and international terrorism matters including money laundering, fraud, and planning of terrorist events. He was also named the Infrastructure Protection Coordinator for the State Office of Homeland Security.
Other positions he has held include Auto Theft Investigator, FBI Gang/Violent Crimes Task Force member and Governor Security Detail.
His nomination must now be approved by the full Senate. Major Rhoades will succeed Michael Thompson who has served in DPS for 25 years.

## Senate Democrats Oppose Budget Cuts <br> Senator John Sparks on behalf of the Senate Democratic Caucus released the following

 statement on the budget cuts passed by the Senate on Wednesday:"The lesson from the failure of the Step Up plan in the House last week isn't that we should move on, it's that we need to continue working and consider proposals in smaller packages. It is shortsighted, premature, and irresponsible to push through so early in the legislative session yet another inadequate budget plan that includes only cuts. A 'yes' vote on these cuts was a vote to abandon negotiations. Instead of giving up and imposing arbitrary cuts, the Republican leadership of the legislature and the Governor should return to the negotiating table.
The Senate Democrats believe we must have a balanced approach that includes new revenues. There are revenue measures that could have been brought to the floor this week that would receive broad bipartisan support, including a $\$ 1.50$ per pack cigarette tax increase and repealing the income tax rate trigger of $5.25 \%$ for the wealthiest earners.
Instead, state agencies will be forced to implement these across the board cuts with only four months remaining in the fiscal year, which will compound their negative impact.
