





This week I would like to talk about some Personal Safety issues, just like with anything else, these tips are not fool proof but will give you the best chance of staying safe. First thing is trust your instincts, this is built in common sense, if you suspect something is wrong it probably is. Don't invite trouble, use your best judgement about where you go and what you do.

Lights: Leave at least one light on inside and outside, when you are not at home. Strangers: Never allow strangers into your home. Ask service people to slip identification under the

door, or call the main office to verify. Have people who claim to need assistance wait outside while you call for assistance.

Phone: Play it smart on the phone. Don't let callers know you are home alone, or the times of day that your home will be empty. You can pretend or give the impression that others live in the home with you. Retrieve messages often. Never give out credit card numbers or other personal information on the phone or online unless you know it is a reputable organization. Vary your routine, changing your daily patterns even slightly might deter an attack, or even a burglary. Elevators: Get on with a

group if possible. Stand away from the door while waiting alone. Don't ride an elevator alone with a stranger; get off immediately if you feel in danger. On the Street: Protect yourself on the street, dress appropriately, avoid flashy clothing or jewelry, they may attract unwanted attention. Dress so you can walk or run easily to avoid an attack. Walk with someone, stay alert to those around you. If you must walk alone, walk confidently. Go into a public place if you need to ask for directions. Avoid isolated areas, parks and parking lots. Avoid shortcuts; they may expose you to danger. Protect your valuables, carry only what you need. Carry those valuables close to your body and don't set them down. Carry a wallet in a front or inside pocket. If you carry a purse carry it close to your body. Avoid hanging your purse on the door or placing it on the floor in public restrooms. If it has a shoulder strap, put that around your neck to avoid putting it down. These tips were taken from the McAlester Safe Neighborhoods program book.

To see what teen boys might experience shopping for supplements, a researcher called the stores and identified himself as a 15year-old football player entering 10th grade.

First, the researcher said he was doing strength training and asked an open-ended question about what the store employee recommended he take to improve his performance. Without prompting, 39 percent of the employees recommended creatine, while only two workers told teens to take testosterone.

Next, the researcher asked specifically about whether the store employee would recommend creatine, and 29 percent did. Roughly 30 percent of the workers advised against creatine, while 2.5 percent of them refused to make recommendations over the phone.

When the researcher asked specifically about testosterone. 9 percent recommended it. But 89 percent of the workers advised against taking testosterone and 1.2 percent of them refused to discuss it over the phone. Last, the researcher asked if he could purchase the supplements on his own if he came to the store. For creatine, 74 percent of the workers said the researcher could come buy it himself, while 23 percent said he would have to be at least 18 years old to make the purchase. With testosterone, 41 percent of the employees said the researcher could buy it, and 56 percent said he would need to be at least 18 years old.




